Following the Rules Youth Night Agenda

Announcements: Let your youth group know of any upcoming events, youth nights, or other activities they should be aware of

Dodgeball: Have the students play a game of dodgeball for about 5-10 minutes. However, announce before they start that there are no rules. If they ask "Can we....?", just repeat "There are no rules". After about 5-10 minutes or until the students are frustrated, announce that they are now going to play a round of dodgeball with the normal dodgeball rules.

Test: Have the students complete the Can You Follow Instructions test

Small Group Discussion: Break into groups depending on how many adults you have available. Make sure each adult has a discussion guide.

Captains' Orders Game: Have one person to be the "Captain". The Captain stands in front of the rest of the group and calls out one of the following actions. The students then complete the action without messing up. If they mess up, they are out. It is similar to "Simon Says" except the students complete each command.

Man Overboard -Players have to drop to the floor into planking position.

Captain's Coming -Players must stand at attention and salute the 'captain'.

Starboard / Port - Players must run to the designated side of the room.

Scrub The Deck -Players must squat on the ground and scrub the deck.

Climb The Rigging -Players must stand up and pretend to climb the rigging.

Man The Lifeboats -Three players have to pair up. They must sit in a row with the two on the end holding their hands out to make a boat shape and the person in the middle rows the boat.

Find North -The players have to pair up into groups of three and point in one direction.

5. Do you think God has given instructions to help us live our lives? (You may get a range of answers which will serve to facilitate a discussion, but probably someone will say the Ten Commandments.)

6. Read over each commandment

- 1. I am the LORD your God. You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only shall you serve.
- 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- 3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day.
- 4. Honor your father and your mother.
- 5. You shall not kill.
- 6. You shall not commit adultery.
- 7. You shall not steal.
- 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
- 10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

7. Select some of the commandments and discuss what that might mean for us today i.e. Idols? Honor your father and mother? Try to include how abortion is included in Number 5.

8. Why did God give these instructions?

9. What do you think would happen if everyone followed these instructions?

10. Are some more important than others? Why?

11. Read **James 2:10**."For whoever keeps the whole law, but falls short in one particular, has become guilty in respect to all of it."

12. Is it possible to keep God's rules without his help?
